

Resolution #1972-3

A Resolution: pertaining to the requirement of guarantee deposits on Utility accounts.

Whereas: it has been deemed necessary and desirable, in the operation of the Municipal Utilities System, to require consumers to make guarantee deposits, and

Whereas: questions arise from time to time regarding certain aspects of this requirement which are not clearly defined, now therefore,

Be It Resolved: by the Public Works Division of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska:

- 1) That each separate meter installed in order to provide electric or water shall constitute a separate account.
- 2) That following the effective date of this resolution, each separate electric or water account shall be subject to a separate guarantee deposit of whatever amount is applicable in accordance with the type of service involved.
- 3) That each such guarantee deposit shall be made at the time an application for service is requested and service shall not be connected for any consumer before such deposit is made.
- 4) That each such guarantee deposit on Rental property shall remain with the Public Works Division as long as the respective account is active, and may be reimbursed at the close or termination of the account only after all bills and charges have been paid.
- 5) That each such guarantee deposit on Owned property shall remain with the Public Works Division for a period of five (5) years and may be reimbursed only after all bills and charges have been paid.
- 6) That the amounts of guarantee deposits for utility service shall be as follows:

<u>Rental Property:</u>	
Residential	- \$20.00
Commercial	- 25.00
<u>Owned Property</u>	
Residential	- \$15.00
Commercial	- 20.00

Be It Resolved: that the foregoing schedule of rates shall supercede all previous rate schedules and all previous resolutions in conflict herewith and the same are hereby rescinded.

Be It Further Resolved: that the foregoing schedule of rates shall become effective the 15th day of November 1972.
