

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, have determined that it is necessary and advisable that the City of Gothenburg extend 16th Street at the Western Corporate limits of said city, a distance of approximately 870.4 feet for purposes of providing a public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, said Mayor and Council have determined that it is necessary and advisable that the City of Gothenburg extend the present public right-of-way owned by the said city in west Gothenburg, a distance of 705.3 feet, said present public right-of-way being more particularly described as commencing at the Southeast (SE) corner of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Twenty-five (25) West of the 6th P.M., thence west a distance of 872.7 feet, thence North, a distance of 30 feet; thence Northwest, a distance of 20.3 feet to the Southeast corner of said public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, said lands are now owned by private parties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska:

That the City Attorney be and is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate with the owners for the purchase of said lands for the purpose of providing a public right-of-way over said lands, with any such purchase subject to the approval of the City Council.
