

RESOLUTION # 1978-1

Point (1) The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska intends to participate in the Land and Water Conservation Fund program for the purpose of development of a softball field and amphitheater.

Point (2) The Mayor is authorized to sign documents to obtain financial assistance, including a project agreement with the State of Nebraska, and

Point (3) Roger French is designated as Project Liaison Officer to work with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission in carrying out the project.

Point (4) The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska has the ability to finance its share of the cost of the proposed project and the financial capability to operate and maintain the completed facility.

Point (5) The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this project proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-354 (1964), and any of the regulations promulgated pursuant to such Act by the Secretary of the Interior and contained in 43 CFR 17.

Point (6) The land to be developed and/or acquired will be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and is dedicated to outdoor recreation uses. Furthermore, the City will not convert these lands to other uses without the express consent of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission and the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation.

Point (7) The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska will, after acquisition and development, exert every effort to preserve the existing beauty and enhancement of the proposed project area and will bury all proposed utility lines within the area.

Point (8) The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska agrees to comply with all state and federal requirements in making the facilities accessible to the handicapped.
