

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, being a party involved in the construction thereof, requires a resolution of the City Council of said City in order to proceed with the study and ultimate construction of said viaduct.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, hereby request the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, to take whatever action necessary to proceed with a study of a highway improvement project, on State Highway No. 47, for a railroad viaduct, with a view toward ultimate construction thereof, the Mayor and Council hereby acknowledging that said City will be required to participate in funding said project.
