

Res 1978-7

was offered by Councilman Nichols who moved for its adoption:

"RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Street Improvement District Nos. 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85 and Storm Sewer District No. 1977-1 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska were duly created and the contracts were let for the construction of certain improvements therein; and

WHEREAS, said improvements have been completed and are hereby accepted by the Mayor and City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

1. That the Mayor and City Council find and determine that the cost of constructing the improvements in Street Improvement District Nos. 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85, including (a) the cost of improvements of intersections and areas formed by the crossing of streets, avenues and alleys, and (b) the cost of the improvements opposite abutting property (being all said improvements exclusive of intersections and areas formed by the crossing of streets, avenues and alleys), is as follows:

2. That the Mayor and City Council shall hold a special meeting at the City Hall in Gothenburg, Nebraska on the 7th day of November, 1978 at 7:00 P. M., for the purpose of sitting as a Board of Equalization and Assessment to equalize and levy special assessments on the lots and parcels of land abutting on or adjacent to the streets, avenues and alleys improved in said Street Improvement District Nos. 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85. Notice of the time of holding such meeting and the purpose for which it is held shall be published in The Gothenburg Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City for at least four weeks (five publications) before the date of said hearing. The City Clerk is directed to cause said notice to be published as provided by statute and to mail a copy of said notice to all interested parties as required by law.

3. The special engineers are directed to prepare and file with the City Clerk a map of the property in said Street Improvement District Nos. 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85 and a tentative schedule of the assessments in said Districts which shall be open for public inspection, upon request, at the office of the City Clerk.

4. The Mayor and City Council further find and determine that the cost of constructing the improvements in Storm Sewer District No. 1977-1 is \$192,769.92, and that all of said improvements constitute general public improvements for the benefit of all property in the City which may properly be financed by the issuance of negotiable bonds of the City to be called Sewer Bonds, payable in not exceeding twenty years. There shall be levied annually upon all the taxable property in the City a tax which shall be sufficient to meet payments of interest and principal of the bonds as the same become due."

The foregoing Resolution having been read, Councilman Stubbs seconded the motion for its adoption and, on roll call, the vote was as follows: "YEA": Wahlgren, Carratt, Stubbs and Nichols
