

RESOLUTION 1980-13

WHEREAS, LB 717 of the 86th Legislature, Second Session, 1980, of the State of Nebraska, provides that the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, may designate parking spaces in the City to be used exclusively by disabled persons, whose motor vehicles bear a handicapped license plate as described in 60-311.14 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, and

WHEREAS, said Legislative Bill further provides that the City Clerk may certify to the Department of Motor Vehicles of the State of Nebraska such other handicapped persons who may be authorized to use said designated parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg is desirous of providing parking stalls within the city for the exclusive use of disabled persons,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA as follows, to-wit:

1. The following parking stalls in the City of Gothenburg are hereby designated to be for the exclusive use of disabled persons, and permittees who have complied with the provisions of Legislative bill 717 of the 86th Legislature, Second Session, 1980, of the State of Nebraska:
  - (a) The first parking stall east of Lake Avenue on the north side of Ninth Street.
  - (b) The first parking stall west of Lake Avenue on the south side of Ninth Street.
2. That the City Clerk shall take all applications and make such certifications as are required to the Department of Motor Vehicles of the State of Nebraska, as set forth in LB 717, 86th Legislature, 1980.

3. That the City forthwith place signs, bearing the international accepted wheel chair symbol immediately adjacent to the above described parking stalls in conformance with the 19th addition of the manual on uniform traffic control devices for streets and highways, issued by the Federal Highway Administration.
