

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 12

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska that certain unlawful bidding practices have occurred on public improvements within the City of Gothenburg; and

WHEREAS, The Attorney General's Office of the State of Nebraska has been investigating such unlawful practices;

WHEREAS, The City desires the Attorney General of the State of Nebraska to investigate and pursue damages on behalf of the City from said unlawful bidding procedures,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby appoints the Attorney General of the State of Nebraska, his deputies, and assistants to make such investigations as the said Attorney General may in his discretion deem necessary, on behalf of the City to determine and uncover unlawful bidding practices on the City Public Improvements.

Section 2. The Attorney General of the State of Nebraska, his deputies and assistants are hereby authorized to negotiate settlements with any persons, partnerships or corporations which the Attorney General deems to have engaged in unlawful bidding practices on Gothenburg Public Improvements and bind the City with regard to said negotiations.

Section 3. The Attorney General of the State of Nebraska, his deputies and assistants are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Gothenburg, any and all documents for settlement of bid rigging disputes on public improvements within the City of Gothenburg, upon such terms as the Attorney General may determine beneficial for the City.


