

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 5

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg has previously installed stop signs on Avenue G stopping traffic northbound at the corner of 10th and Avenue G, and stopping traffic southbound at the corner of 10th and Avenue G; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg has determined that the traffic flow should be altered at the intersection of 10th and Avenue G; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a change in the placement of the stop signs at the location of 10th and Avenue G will affect such a purpose.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The proper authorities of the City of Gothenburg shall place a stop sign stopping the flow of traffic eastbound on 10th Street at Avenue G and stopping the traffic westbound on 10th Street at Avenue G.

Section 2. The placement of the stop sign shall conform in all respects to the standards set forth in the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. The stop signs currently stopping traffic northbound on Avenue G at 10th Street, and southbound on Avenue G at 10th Street shall be removed upon the placement of the stop signs as set forth in Section 1.
