

RESOLUTION 1983-7

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Department of Correctional Services, through the Federal Surplus Property Assistance Section, by authority of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, (40 USC 484) as amended, makes available federal surplus personal property to public agencies for public purposes and to nonprofit tax-exempt health and educational institutions, and

WHEREAS, City of Gothenburg, hereafter referred to as the Applicant, is desirous of utilizing the services and resources of this agency, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant certifies that it is a public agency or a nonprofit educational or health institution exempt from taxation under Section 501 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant further certifies that property is needed and will be used by the recipient for carrying out or promoting for the residents of a given political area one or more public purposes and for no other purposes, or

WHEREAS, the Applicant further certifies that property is needed for and will be used by the recipient for educational or public health purposes including research and for no other purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant agrees that all items of property shall be placed in use for the purposes for which acquired within one year of receipt and shall be continued in use for such purposes for one year from the date the property was placed in use, and in the event the property is not so placed in use, or continued in use, the donee shall immediately notify the State Agency, and return said property to the State Agency as directed, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant further agrees to abide by all additional periods of restriction placed on property by the State Agency; that is, 30 months on all passenger motor vehicles and other items of property with a unit acquisition cost of \$3,000 or more, except for such items of major equipment on which the State Agency designates a further period of restrictions as indicated on the distribution document, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant further agrees that during the period of restriction, it will not sell, trade, lease, lend, bail, encumber, or otherwise dispose of such property without prior approval of the General Services Administration or the State Agency, and in the event property is so disposed of without prior approval of the General Services Administration or the State Agency, the Applicant will be liable for the fair market value or the fair rental value of such property as determined by the General Services Administration or the State Agency, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant certifies that it will file assurance of compliance with GSA regulations under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 605 of Title VI of the Federal Property and Administrative Service Act of 1949, as amended and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant further agrees to remit promptly to the State Agency for all service and handling fees on property acquired, and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Applicant requests that eligibility be established to participate in the State Federal Property Assistance Program, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Blaine Peterson, Mayor be authorized to act on behalf of the governing body of the Applicant in acquiring federal surplus property and so obligate said governing body to the aforementioned certifications and agreements, and that such person be authorized, at his discretion, to further delegate authority to any agent of the Applicant organization for the purpose of acquiring surplus property for use by the Applicant Organization.

CIVIL RIGHTS ASSURANCE

City of Gothenburg
(NAME OF DONEE)

hereinafter called the "donee," hereby agrees

that for or in connection with which any property is donated to the donee will be conducted in compliance with, and the donee will comply with and will require any other person (any legal entity) who through contractual or other arrangements with the donee is authorized to provide services or benefits under said program to comply with, all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations of the General Services Administration (41 CFR 101-6.2) issued under the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, Section 606 of Title VI of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, Section 303 of the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, and in the United States shall on the ground of race, color, national origin, sex, age, education, or that no otherwise qualified handicapped person shall solely by reason of the handicap, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the donee received Federal Assistance from the General Services Administration; and Hereby Gives Assurance That it will immediately take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement.

The Donee further agrees that this agreement shall be subject in all respects to the provisions of said regulations; that this agreement shall obligate the donee for the period during which it retains ownership or possession of any such property; that the United States shall have the right to seek judicial enforcement of this agreement; and, this agreement shall be binding upon any successor in interest of the donee and the word "donee" as used herein includes any such successor in interest.
