NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All persons, who do not have their principal place of residence in the City of Gothenburg, and all firms and corporations who do not have their principal place of business in the City of Gothenburg, shall be charged for use of the municipal land fill according to the following schedule.

- a. Trucks and four wheeled trailers, \$35.00 per load.
- b. Pick ups and two wheeled trailers, \$10.00 per load.
- c. Automobiles and similar type vehicles, \$2.50 per load.

Section 2. Commercial refuse collectors who collect refuse from municipalities other than Gothenburg and dump the same in the municipal land fill shall be charged an annual fee of \$75.00 for such privilege.

Section 3. The rates established by this resolution shall become effective the 1 day of FEBRUARY, 1985.

Section 4. The Clerk is hereby directed to file this rate in her office and keep the same available for public inspection.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following individuals, businesses, and entities, shall pay for the use of the municipal land fill in accordance with Section 2 hereof:

- a. Non-residents of the City of Gothenburg and non-residents of the immediate rural trade area of the City of Gothenburg.
- b. All businesses and entities who do not have their principal place of business in the City of Gothenburg or who do not have their principal place of business in the immediate rural trade area of the City of Gothenburg.
- c. Commercial refuse collectors who collect refuse from municipalities other than Gothenburg and dump the same in the municipal land fill.

Section 2. The rates for the use of the municipal land fill, payable by those persons, businesses, and entities enumerated in Section 1 are as follows:

- a. Trucks and four-wheeled trailers, \$35.00 per load.
- b. Pickups and two-wheeled trailers, \$10.00 per load.
- c. Automobiles and similar type vehicles, \$2.50 per load.
- d. Commercial refuse collectors collecting from municipalities other than Gothenburg, \$75.00 annually.

Section 3. The rates established by this resolution shall become effective the _____ day of _____, 1985.

Section 4. The Clerk is hereby directed to file this resolution in her office and keep the same available for public inspection.

ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-310 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE UNLAWFUL MISREPRESENTATION TO ACQUIRE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Section 6-310 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Section 6-310 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6-310 MISDEMEANORS; MISREPRESENTATION BY MINOR.
It shall be unlawful for any minor to represent that he is of the age of twenty-one (21) years, or older, for the purpose of asking for, purchasing, or receiving any alcoholic beverages. (Ref. 53-180.01 RS Neb.)

Section 3. There is an emergency, in that it is necessary to immediately change the penal provisions of the Gothenburg Municipal Code to conform to State law, and three-fourths or more of the Council have voted for the passage of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately, be posted in three public places and published according to law.

§6-309 MISDEMEANORS; DRUNKENNESS. Any person found in a state of intoxication, or under the influence of intoxicating liquor, within the Municipality shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in accord with State law. (Ref. 53-196 RS Neb.)

§6-310 MISDEMEANORS; MISREPRESENTATION BY MINOR. It shall be unlawful for any minor to represent that he is of the age of nineteen (19) years for the purpose of asking for, purchasing, or receiving any alcoholic beverages. (Ref. 53-180.01 RS Neb.)

§6-311 MISDEMEANORS; MINOR IN POSSESSION. It shall be unlawful for any person under nineteen (19) years of age to transport, knowingly possess, or have under his control in any motor vehicle, beer or other alcoholic liquor on any public street,

alley, roadway, or property owned by the State of Nebraska or any subdivision thereof, or any other place within the Municipal limits. (Ref. 53-180.02 RS Neb.)

ORDINANCE NO. 487

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-311 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Section 6-311 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Section 6-311 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6-311 MISDEMEANORS; MINOR IN POSSESSION. It shall be unlawful for any person under twenty-one (21) years of age to transport, knowingly possess, or have under his control in any motor vehicle, beer or other alcoholic liquor on any public street, alley, roadway, or property owned by the State of Nebraska or any subdivision thereof, or any other place within the Municipal limits, provided however, it shall not be unlawful for a person who attained their 20th birthday by January 1, 1985 to so possess or control alcoholic liquor. (Ref. 53-180.02 RS Neb.)

Section 3. There is an emergency, in that it is necessary to immediately change the penal provisions of the Gothenburg Municipal Code to conform to State law, and three-fourths or more of the Council have voted for the passage of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately, be posted in three public places and published according to law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-605 OF THE GOTHENBURG MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES IN A NEWSPAPER, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES IN PAMPHLET FORM; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Section 1-605 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 1-605 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1-605. ORDINANCES; PUBLICATION. All ordinances of a general nature shall be published one (1) time within fifteen (15) days after they are passed in some newspaper published in the Municipality, or if no paper is published in the Municipality, then by posting a written or printed copy thereof in each of three (3) public places in the Municipality. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, in the event that an ordinance exceeds _____ pages in length, said ordinance may be published in book or pamphlet form.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective, from and after its publication according to law.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg deems it in the best interest of the City to provide additional parking stalls in the City of Gothenburg for the exclusive use of disabled person,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following parking places are hereby designated to be for the exclusive use of disabled persons, and permittees who have complied with the provisions of LB 717 of the 86th Legislature, Second Session, 1980, of the State of Nebraska:

- a. The first east-bound parking place on the south side of 10th Street and immediately adjacent to Lake Avenue.
- b. The last east-bound parking place on the south side of the street on 10th Street and immediately west of Lake Avenue in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 2. The City shall forthwith place a sign bearing the internationally accepted wheel chair symbol immediately adjacent to the above described parking places in conformance with the latest edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control devices for streets and highways, issued by the Federal Highway Administration.
