

RESOLUTION NO. 85- 2

WHEREAS, The city Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, has determined that Fourth Street, lying west of Highway 47, within the City limits, is used primarily for heavy truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Gothenburg, and the safety of the citizens therein, that no vehicle be parked along the above described street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective on the 15th day after the publication of this resolution, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to park along that portion of Fourth Street in the City of Gothenburg, lying west of Highway 47.

Section 2. This resolution is passed pursuant to Section 5-602 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code.

Section 3. A violation of this resolution shall be punished pursuant to Section 5-618, et seg. of the Gothenburg Municipal Code.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to published this resolution and post the same in three public places, forthwith.
