

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 1

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg has determined the need to establish an unloading zone within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that parking should be prohibited in said zone during certain hours,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The areas on the east side of Avenue F, commencing at a point 37 feet and south of the south curb line of 9th Street and continuing South for a distance of 18 feet is hereby designated as an "unloading zone".

Section 2. No vehicles shall park in said unloading zone during the hours of 3:00 A.M. to 8:00 A.M., except for the express purpose of unloading freight.

Section 3. The street superintendent shall post such signs as are necessary to advise the public of the existence of said zone.

Section 4. Any person parking in said zone in violation of this resolution shall be punished according to law.
