NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Gothenburg as follows:

Provided that:


- (1) Complete and detailed studies of potential siting in Dawson County have been conducted including those scheduled for 1989 and beyond and such studies result in unequivocal suitability for facility location.
- (2) Full consideration has been given to geological and hydrological conditions and potential harm, if any, to surface or ground water.
- (3) Said site or sites meets all Federal, State and Central Interstate Compact rules and regulations and will have only an above grade facility.
- (4) Said site or sites is a suitable site as determined by the Citizens Advisory Committee and ultimately is recommended as a final candidate for facility location.
- (5) All other relevant considerations mandate a conclusion that the site considered herein represents the best alternative, in light of all circumstances, for facility location in the state of Nebraska.

The Mayor and Council on behalf of the City of Gothenburg hereby agree to host the Central Interstate Compact low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.
