RESOLUTION NO. 1990-16

RESOLUTION WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN EXERCISE/
JOGGING TRAIL AT LAKE HELEN, GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, intends to participate in the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program for the purpose of developing an exercise/jogging trail at Lake Helen, Gothenburg, NE.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign documents to obtain financial assistance, including a project agreement with the State of Nebraska, and all other documents/agreements relevant to said development.

Section 3. The City of Gothenburg has the ability to finance its share of the cost of the proposed project and the financial capability to operate and maintain the completed facility.

Section 4. The City of Gothenburg will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, age, religion, handicap, sex or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to the project proposal and shall comply with the terms and intent of Title VI of Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.O. 880-354 (1964) and any of the regulations promulgated pursuant to such Act by the Secretary of the Interior and contained in 43 CFR 17.

Section 5. No property acquired and/or developed under this project shall, without the approval of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission and the Secretary of the Interior, be converted to nonpublic outdoor recreation uses. Such approval may be granted only if it is in accord with the then existing Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP) and only upon such conditions as deemed necessary to assure the substitution of other recreation properties of at least equal fair market value and of reasonably equivalent usefulness and location.






Section 7. The City of Gothenburg agrees to comply with all State and federal requirements in making the facilities accessible to the handicapped.
