

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-6

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, a municipal corporation and City of second class, pass a resolution supporting the unity of Dawson County in the process of redistricting the Nebraska Legislature.

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Legislature is now engaged in the process of establishing new boundaries for the legislative districts; and

WHEREAS, Legislative District No. 39 is or may be restructured as a part of the process; and

WHEREAS, certain proposals have been or may be advanced which may result in dividing Dawson County into more than one legislative district; and

WHEREAS, Dawson County is unique among the counties within the State of Nebraska by having three cities of substantial size with similar geographic and economic interests; and,

WHEREAS, during the past five years a major effort by representatives of the communities in Dawson County has resulted in a new level of cooperation never before attained; and,

WHEREAS, Dawson County, as a political unit, enables its citizens to be heard in the Nebraska Legislature because of its population of 19,940 and its unified agricultural and economic base. If divided, the citizens of Dawson County may lose this ability.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

The undersigned does hereby request the members of the Nebraska Legislature, as part of the redistricting process, to not consider or adopt any proposal which would result in dividing Dawson County into more than one legislative district.
