

RESOLUTION 1992- 18

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT OF YIELD SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF NINTH STREET AND "H" AVENUE AND FIFTH STREET AND "A" AVENUE IN THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG.

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized to provide for the installation and designation of certain street signs, including yield signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that east and west bound traffic should be regulated at the corners of Ninth Street and "H" Avenue by the placement of yield signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that east and west bound traffic should be regulated at the intersection of Fifth Street and "A" Avenue by the placement of yield signs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. East bound and west bound traffic on Ninth Street at its intersection with Avenue "H" in the City of Gothenburg are required to yield to north and south bound traffic on said Avenue "H" and yield signs shall be placed on Ninth Street at said intersection in accordance with the uniform traffic control device standard established by the State of Nebraska.

Section 2. East bound and west bound traffic on Fifth Street at its intersection with Avenue "A" in the City of Gothenburg are required to yield to north and south bound traffic on said Avenue "A" and yield signs shall be placed on Fifth

Street at said intersection in accordance with the uniform traffic control device standard established by the State of Nebraska.

Section 3. All current yield signs which do not conform with Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be removed.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon the placement of signs in accordance with Paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof.

Section 5. Any person violating this resolution shall be punishable by fine of not to exceed \$100.00 per occurrence.




