

Must pay
#4,000 total cost

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 23

WHEREAS, the Bureau of the Census has been requested to do a recount of the population of Dawson County in 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg has been requested to participate in payment for such recount;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Gothenburg will pay the initial cost, subject to Paragraph 2 hereof, as follows:

Dawson County shall pay 20% of the initial cost. The remaining cost shall be split prorata, based on population shown in the 1990 Census among the cities of Lexington, Cozad, Overton, and Gothenburg. Initial cost to the City of Gothenburg will be \$8,004.00


Section 2. Upon determination of the new census after the recount, cities' and the county's costs will be recalculated based upon the benefit to each respective governmental unit received from state and federal funding sources. The benefit will be calculated by determining the gross additional benefit from state and federal funding sources by virtue of the recount for the cities of Lexington, Cozad, Overton, Gothenburg and the County of Dawson. Payments will then be made among the governmental units to reflect the final cost benefit. The final payments will be made as soon a practicable after the amount of such benefits are known.

Section 3. The City of Gothenburg will make the payments and obligate itself based upon the foregoing resolution in


the event that the cities of Lexington, Cozad, Overton, and Dawson County pass resolutions which provide the same funding mechanism for such census recount.
