

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 25

WHEREAS, the City Council has a Museum Feasibility Study Committee to report on the advisability of creating a museum in the City of Gothenburg; and

WHEREAS, the advisory Committee has recommended the creation of a privately funded museum located at Lake Helen and which would involve the relocation of the Pony Express Station; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to seek the consent of the electorate regarding the relocation of the Pony Express Station;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:


That at the November, 1992 general election, the following issue shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Gothenburg:

It has been proposed that a Pony Express Center consisting of a museum, with free admission, and other facilities, be built and funded from donations. If fully funded, it is proposed that the Pony Express Station be moved to the museum site at Lake Helen.


