

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 8

RESOLUTION DIRECTING SALE OF CERTAIN ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY LESS THAN \$1,000.00 IN VALUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg is in possession of certain items of personal property less than \$1,000.00 in value; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer has the need to retain such property; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and proper that the City sell such personal property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following property be sold in the manner and terms and subject to the conditions set forth hereafter.


1. One bullet proof vest will be sold to Cort Bullock for \$165.00, after posting this resolution for a period of seven days in three public places.

2. The City of Gothenburg will accept sealed written bids to purchase scrap iron cut from the old jail. Said bids must be on a per pound basis and require payment in cash or certified funds when picked up. Bids must be in the office of the City Clerk by noon, March 10, 1992. The property will be picked up, removed and paid for on the 13th day of March, 1992 by the highest bidder. Notice of the intended sale shall be posted in three public places for a period of seven days.

3. The City shall advertise and sell one used concrete saw by advertising in the magazines of the Nebraska League of Municipalities, and in the Gothenburg Times. Said saw shall be sold to the highest bidder within thirty days after the first publication in the League magazine, without further action by the City.


