

RESOLUTION 1993 - 12

A special election is hereby called and shall be held in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska on October 19, 1993, at which election there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City the following question:

"Shall the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax? If a majority of votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such tax, then the City of Gothenburg shall be empowered as provided by Section 77-27,142 and shall proceed forthwith to impose a tax pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the City of Gothenburg shall not impose such tax.

The Sales and use tax imposed shall be at the rate of one-half percent, in addition to the one-half percent currently imposed, and shall continue only for a four (4) year period. The proceeds of such one-half percent tax shall be used to pay for the principal, interest, costs of issuance and all related costs of bonds to be issued by the City of Gothenburg for the additions, repairs and improvement to and acquiring equipment for the Gothenburg Municipal Swimming Pool, provided, however, that the City will not impose said tax for the purposes specified herein unless the electors of the City shall approve the issuance of Bonds, the proceeds of which shall be used for making additions, repairs and improvements to and acquiring equipment for the Gothenburg Municipal Swimming Pool.

All funds collected in excess of the amount needed to retire the bonds, interest and related costs will be paid to the general fund of the City of Gothenburg in relief of general tax obligations."

The ballots to be voted shall set forth the above proposition stated, followed by the words "YES (FOR SAID TAX)" and "NO (AGAINST SAID TAX)" with a square opposite each. Voters desiring to vote in favor of said proposition shall mark an "X" in the square receding the word "YES", voters desiring to vote against said proposition shall mark an "X" preceding the word "NO".


Polls for voting at said election shall remain open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Central Daylight Savings Time, on said date and the polling places shall be designated the Election Commissioner of Dawson County, Nebraska, as provided by law.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Election Commissioner of Dawson County, who shall designate the polling places, appoint the election officials and otherwise conduct the election as provided by law. The City agrees to reimburse the Election Commissioner for all expenses incurred in conducting the election.


The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed, in conjunction with the Election Commissioner conducting the election, to arrange for the printing of the necessary ballots for said election appropriate or necessary in order to cause said proposition to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City as above provided. The City Clerk is also directed to publish notice of said election in **The Gothenburg Times** in at least one issue not more than thirty nor less than ten days prior to the election and to cause a sample ballot to be published in **The Gothenburg Times** not more than ten nor less than three days prior to the election.
