

RESOLUTION 1993- 15

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg, has established an Enhanced 911 Emergency Telephone Response Operation;

WHEREAS, said 911 Emergency Telephone Response Operation requires the naming of roadways in and around the Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska area for purposes of establishing addresses;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That roadway running along the westerly and northerly boundaries of Lake Helen in the City of Gothenburg, from a point commencing at the intersection of 20th Street and Avenue A in the City of Gothenburg and terminating at a point where 27th Street and State Highway 47 intersect, is hereby named LAKEVIEW DRIVE.

2. That roadway which runs generally along the 1/2 section line in Section 15, Township 11 North, Range 25, West of the 6th P.M., Dawson County, Nebraska from a point where said roadway meets U.S. Highway 30, on the north, to its terminus on the south, (extended into Section 22 in said township and range) is hereby named "Cottonwood Drive".
