

CITY OF GOTHENBURG
Resolution 1993-5

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska is required by the Nebraska Integrated Solid Waste Management Act, (Nebraska Revised Statute Section 13-2001 to 13-2043) to provide or contract facilities and systems as necessary for the safe and sanitary disposal of solid waste generated within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of this governmental subdivision to enter into the INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CREATING THE LEXINGTON AREA SOLID WASTE AGENCY.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, BY THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA, as follows:

1.) That the INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CREATING THE LEXINGTON SOLID WASTE AGENCY attached to this Resolution is hereby approved, and that Richard Blase, Mayor of the City of Gothenburg is hereby authorized and directed to sign said INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT on behalf of this political subdivision.


2.) That Bruce Clymer is hereby appointed as the representative of this governing body to serve on the Agency Board created by said INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, such appointment to continue until a successor has been duly appointed.

3.) That pending the first meeting of the Agency Board created by said INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, Bill Podraza, City Manager of Lexington, Nebraska, is hereby appointed as temporary officer and directed to publish notice of the first meeting of said Agency to be held June 1, 1993 at 7:00 P.M. at the Lexington City Building.
