A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, was held at the City Hall in said City on the 6th day of September, 1994, at seven o'clock p.m. Present were: Mayor: Richard Blase; Council Members: Larry Franzen, Joyce Hudson, Kenneth Christensen, Gary Norseen.

Absent: none.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Gothenburg Times, a designated method for giving notice, as show by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to the Mayor and all members of the Council. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to fully consider objections to the passage of the Resolution of Necessity for sanitary sewer improvements in Sanitary Sewer District No. 27 of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, as proposed at a meeting of the Mayor and Council held on the 6th day of September, 1994, and spread at length on the minutes of that meeting and to consider objections to the making of the improvements as provided for in such resolution.

The Clerk reported that no protests to the proposed improvements or to the Resolution of Necessity were filed in his office prior to the time set for such filing.

Council Member Christensen then introduced the following resolution:

The Mayor and Council hereby find and determine: That there was proposed at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, on the 6th day of September, 1994, a Resolution of Necessity for the construction of improvements to the existing sewage collection system of the City, which improvements shall consist of an eight inch diameter

sanitary sewer main to be constructed within Avenue L right-of-way within the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, together with such other necessary appurtenances thereto as may be required; that notice of pendency of said Resolution was published as provided by law; that the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, having considered the proposed Resolution of Necessity and there being no written objections thereto, that said Resolution of Necessity so presented and proposed be adopted as proposed.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:


