

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, was held at the City Council Chambers in Gothenburg on the 20th day of September, 1994, at 7 o'clock p.m. Present were: Mayor: Richard L. Blase; Council Members: Larry Franzen, Joyce Hudson, Kenneth Christensen, Gary Norseen

Advance notice of the meeting was published in The Gothenburg Times, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to the Mayor and all members of the Council, and a copy of the acknowledgment of receipts of notice and the agenda is also attached to the minutes. The advance notice and the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting contained information regarding the availability of the agenda. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Council Member Christensen introduced the attached resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-16

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of September, 1994, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, the Council set to determine the sufficiency of objections to the creation of Street Improvement District No. 107; and

WHEREAS, the City received no objections in writing and no one appeared in objection to the creation of said improvement district;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS;

The Mayor and Council hereby find and determine:

1. That the Mayor and Council have heretofore created Street Improvement District No. 107; that notice of the creation of Street Improvement District No. 107 was published as required by law; the notice set the time of 7:00 p.m., September 20, 1994, and the place, being the City Hall in Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska for hearing to determine the sufficiency of written objections to the creation of Street Improvement District No. 107; that no objections were filed; That no one appeared at said hearing to present objections; and all objections have been considered and all persons present have been heard.

2. It is determined that:

(a) the number of resident owners of property directly abutting the streets or alleys to be improved in the District in which objections were filed is:

(b) the number of owners filing written objections to the creation of the district is:

3. The objections to District No. 107 are hereby determined to be insufficient, all required facts and conditions for the creation of the District exist and the governing body shall forthwith cause the improvements to be made in the District.
