

RESOLUTION 1995-26

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, has a concern for the oral health of its residents; and

WHEREAS the City Council has held a public hearing on the desires of the citizens to have the municipal water supply treated with fluoride; and

WHEREAS the evidence provided by trained health professionals in the City overwhelmingly supports the conclusion that many citizens will benefit from the implementation of water fluoridation, especially poor and disadvantaged children;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council finds that is in the best interest of the residents of the City to implement water fluoridation in the Gothenburg municipal water supply.


