## RESOLUTION NO. 1996-17

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Department of Roads has set aside a total of \$100,000 to be used for transportation enhancement projects specifically for the second three Lied Main Street communities in Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds have been made available by Title 23 of the United States Code, providing for said improvements; and

WHEREAS the Federal share payable shall be 80 per cent (80%) per centum of the eligible project costs thereof, with the other 20 per cent (20%) per centum provided by the City of Gothenburg; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg hereby agrees to maintain the project indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg do herewith pledge their full support, endorsement, and cooperation in applying for new ISTEA funds to develop the corner along the Lincoln Highway (Highway 30 and Lake Avenue) for the downtown Gothenburg area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Gothenburg hereby gives permission to the Gothenburg Main Street Program to apply for the 1996 ISTEA moneys set aside specifically for the second three Lied Main Street Communities.
