

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-17

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to place stop signs for the purpose of regulating traffic at the intersection of 22nd Street and Avenue J in the City limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. All East and West bound traffic on 22nd Street within the City Limits shall come to a complete stop prior to entering onto Avenue J.

Section 2. Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of Avenue J and 22nd Street stopping all East and West bound traffic. Said signs shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of said stop signs.
