

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-18

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to place stop signs for the purpose of regulating traffic at the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue C in the City limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. All North and South bound traffic on Avenue C within the City Limits shall come to a complete stop prior to entering onto 9th Street.

Section 2. Stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue C stopping all North and South bound traffic. Said signs shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of said stop signs.


