

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-28

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to place stop signs for the purpose of regulating traffic at the intersection of 4th Street at Hwy #47 and the intersection of 4th Street and Cottonwood Drive in the City limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All West bound traffic on 4th Street within the City Limits shall come to a complete stop prior to entering onto Hwy #47.

Section 2. All East bound traffic on 4th Street within the City Limits shall come to a complete stop prior to entering onto Cottonwood Drive.

Section 3. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of 4th Street and Hwy #47 stopping all West bound traffic. Said sign shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 4. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of 4th Street and Cottonwood Drive stopping all East bound traffic. Said sign shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 5. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of 4th Street and Ave. F stopping all South bound traffic. Said sign shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of said stop signs.


