

RESOLUTION 1997-32

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council is authorized to restrict parking on city streets; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Gothenburg to restrict parking on the east curb line of Avenue J from the intersection of 12th Street and Avenue J, southwesterly for a distance of 97 feet to "loading and unloading driveway" of GRN, in the City of Gothenburg;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on that portion of Avenue J, described as follows:


Commencing at the intersection of 12th Street and Avenue J, thence southwesterly along the east curb line of Avenue J, a distance of 97 feet, within the corporate City Limits of City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska;

Section 2. The area described in Section 1 hereof shall be designated as a No Parking Area and the Director of Public Works is directed to place appropriate signage and curb markings in accordance with the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.


Section 3. Any person violating this Resolution shall be punished in accordance with the Gothenburg Municipal Code, as amended from time to time.
