

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-6

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg has opened L Street between 23rd Street and 27th Street in the City of Gothenburg;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to place stop signs for the purpose of regulating traffic at the intersection of 23rd Street and Avenue L in the City limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All eastbound traffic on 23rd Street within the City Limits shall come to a complete stop prior to entering onto L Street.

Section 2. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Avenue L and 23rd Street stopping all eastbound traffic. Said sign shall be in conformance with the standards set forth in the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of said stop sign.




