

RESOLUTION 1998-18

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council are authorized to restrict parking on city streets; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Gothenburg to restrict parking on the south curb line of 9th Street from the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue B, easterly for a distance of 40 feet, in the City of Gothenburg;

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Gothenburg to restrict parking on the east curb line of Avenue B from the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue B, southerly for a distance of 30 feet, in the City of Gothenburg;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on that portion of 9th Street, described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue B, thence easterly along the south curb line of 9th Street, a distance of 50 feet, within the corporate City Limits of City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska;

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on that portion of Avenue B, described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of 9th Street and Avenue B, thence southerly along the east curb line of Avenue B, a distance of 30 feet, within the corporate City Limits of City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska;


Section 3. The area described in Sections 1 and 2 hereof shall be designated as a No Parking Area and the Director of Public Works is directed to place appropriate signage and curb markings in accordance with the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.

Section 4. Any person violating this Resolution shall be punished in accordance with the Gothenburg Municipal Code, as amended from time to time.


