

**RESOLUTION 1998- 8**

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, from time to time deems it appropriate to sell and dispose of excess personal property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska deems it appropriate to sell certain excess property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Gothenburg hereby deems the following described personal property to be excess property not needed by the City of Gothenburg, to-wit:

- 1 - 1990 Chevy Lumina
- 1 - 1981 Ford F-100 Pick-up
- 1 - 1975 LeRoi Portable Air-compressor
- 1 - Heston 180 Riding Mower
- 3 - Floating Aerators with 20 hp Electrical Motors
- 1 - 3/5 hp Push Mower
- 1 - Pressure Tank and Pump
- 2 - Pool Diving Board
- 1 - Pool Slide
- 5 - Pool Ladders
- 1 - Shower Water Heater
- 1 - Pool Water Heater
- 1 - 2-3 inch Pumps with Electrical Motors

Section 2. The above described personal property shall be sold on the 23 day of April,

1998 by public auction at the Council Chambers of the City Hall at the hour of 5:30 p.m.


Section 4. Following the passage of this Resolution, the clerk shall post notice of the proposed sale in three prominent places within the City for a period of not less than 7 days prior to the sale of the property. The notice shall give general description of the property offered for sale and state the terms and conditions of sale.

Section 5. The property shall be sold "as is" without warranties of any kind expressed or implied; and each item of property is declared to be of less value than \$5,000.00.


Section 6. Payment in full shall be required by good funds at the completion of the auction.


