

RESOLUTION 1999- 10

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 206 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, place stop signs at appropriate locations within the City or remove the same; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to provide for stop signs requiring all traffic west bound on 6th Street to stop prior to entering on 1st Avenue

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place stop signs at the intersections on 6th Street requiring all traffic to stop west bound prior into entering 1st Avenue.

Section 2. The Street Superintendent is directed to erect such signs in accordance with the latest addition of the Manual Of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of such stop signs.
