

RESOLUTION 1999-13

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 206 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, place stop signs at appropriate locations within the City or remove the same; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to place a stop sign requiring all traffic south bound on 1st Avenue to stop prior to crossing 4th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place a stop sign at the intersection on 4th Street and 1st Avenue requiring all traffic to stop south bound on 1st Avenue prior to entering 4th Street.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of such stop sign.
