

RESOLUTION 1999- 17

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council are authorized to restrict parking on city streets;
and

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Gothenburg to restrict parking on the west curb line of Avenue F commencing at the intersection of 8th Street and Avenue F and continuing for a distance of 30 feet north, in the City of Gothenburg;

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council have determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Gothenburg to restrict parking on the west curb line of Avenue F commencing at the intersection of 8th Street and Avenue F with the point of beginning being at a point 104 feet north and continuing for a distance of 36 feet north, in the City of Gothenburg;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on that portion of the west curb line of Avenue F, described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of 8th Street and Avenue F and continuing north for a distance of 30 feet, in the City of Gothenburg.

AND

Commencing at a point 104 feet north of the intersection of 8th Street and Avenue F and continuing north for a distance of 36 feet, in the City of Gothenburg;

Section 2. The area described in Section 1 hereof shall be designated as a No Parking Area and the Director of Public Works is directed to place appropriate signage and curb markings in accordance with the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.

Section 3. Any person violating this Resolution shall be punished in accordance with the Gothenburg Municipal Code, as amended from time to time.
