## RESOLUTION 1999- 3

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Public Power District has asked the City of Gothenburg to sign a Memorandum of Understanding in regard to a Wholesale Power Contract; and

WHEREAS, said Memorandum contains language and concepts that may or may not be acceptable to the City of Gothenburg in a new Wholesale Power Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg has received a letter from Gary Wesphal, Vice President of Wholesale for the Nebraska Public District stating that said Memorandum is a symbolic gesture and is not a legally binding document; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg recognizes that the signing of said Memorandum allows the City of Gothenburg to address issues that may arise in the formation of the Wholesale Power Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg recognizes the importance to help formulate contractual obligations that will be of benefit, not only to our community, but all wholesale customers of the Nebraska Public Power District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg recognizes Public Power has been beneficial to all citizens of the State of Nebraska.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG that the Mayor of the City of Gothenburg shall sign said Memorandum under the aforesaid mentioned provisions of the Resolution; and such Resolution shall be attached to the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Wholesale Power Supply.
