

RESOLUTION 1999- 9

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 206 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, place stop signs at appropriate locations within the City or remove the same; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to remove stop signs requiring all traffic both north and south bound on 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue to stop prior to crossing 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to remove stop signs at the intersection on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue requiring all traffic to stop both north and south bound.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the removal of such stop signs.
