

RESOLUTION 2000-15

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 206 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, place stop signs at appropriate locations within the City or remove the same; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to place a stop sign requiring all traffic south bound and north bound on Lake Avenue to stop prior to crossing 9th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place stop signs at the intersection of Lake Avenue and 9th Street requiring all traffic to stop south bound and north bound on Lake Avenue prior to entering 9th Street.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of such stop signs.
