

RESOLUTION 2000- 7

WHEREAS: The city of Gothenburg, through its Public Works Division, is a retail distributor of electrical power to residents and businesses within its distribution area; and

WHEREAS: Improvement of electrical load efficiency within the electrical system of the city of Gothenburg results in a lower overall cost of electrical power to residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS: Encouraging the use of electrical heating, cooling and water heater systems results in improved load efficiency; and

WHEREAS: The Nebraska Public Power District, the current wholesale electrical power supplier to the city, provides a rebate program for the purchase and installation of heating, cooling and water heater units; and


WHEREAS: The city of Gothenburg wishes to adopt a rebate program similar to that of the Nebraska Public Power District for the encouragement of electrical load efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:


1. The city of Gothenburg hereby adopts an electrical rebate program for all residents and businesses within the Gothenburg electrical distribution area for the purchase of electrical heating, cooling and water heater units installed after the date hereof.
2. The city of Gothenburg shall rebate to the consumer within such distribution area an amount equal to the rebate of the Nebraska Public Power District for installation of heating, cooling and water heater appliances.
3. The administration of the city shall provide an application process for the rebate program.
4. All rebate payments to such consumers shall be made from the Gothenburg electrical enterprise/proprietary fund and not from any general or tax based fund.
