

RESOLUTION NO. 2003- 12

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DAWSON COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS SUPPORT OF CHANGING THE SPEED
LIMITS FOR HIGHWAY 30 IN DAWSON COUNTY,
NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the City of Gothenburg that the Nebraska State Department of Roads has completed a transportation study on Highway 30 through Dawson County; and

WHEREAS, that study indicates that the speed limit could safely be set at 65 miles per hour on Highway 30 throughout Dawson County; and

WHEREAS, the speed limit in Dawson County is currently set at 60 miles per hour on Highway 30; and

WHEREAS, the limits adopted for Highway 30 in Lincoln and Keith County directly west of Dawson County have been changed to 65 miles per hour as a result of the State's study; and


WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg agrees with the recommendations of the State Department of Roads and asks that the Dawson County Commissioners reconsider their objections to the raising of the speed limit:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:


Section I. That the recommendations of the Nebraska Department of Roads be reconsidered by Dawson County Commissioners for changing of the speed limits to 65 miles per hour.

Section II. That in the event the Commissioners do not agree with the recommendations of the State of Nebraska Department of Roads in full, they consider changing the portion of Highway 30 from Gothenburg west to the County line.
