BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council hereby finds and determines: That the City is duly organized as a City of the Second Class; that the City has heretofore issued its Series 1996 Electric System Revenue Bonds dated May 1, 1996, the outstanding Bonds of which mature and bear interest as follows:

Section 2. All of the Outstanding Bonds maturing on May 1, 2008, May 1, 2009 and May 1, 2010 in the aggregate principal amount of \$115,000, be and they are hereby irrevocably

called for payment and redemption on December 15, 2003. Said Bonds are to be presented for payment on December 15, 2003, at the office of Wells Fargo Bank Nebraska, National Association, as successors to National Bank of Commerce Trust and Savings Association, Lincoln, Nebraska, as Paying Agent and Registrar.

Section 3. A true copy of this Resolution shall be filed by the Clerk of the City with Wells Fargo Bank Nebraska, National Association, as Paying Agent and Registrar. Said Paying Agent and Registrar is hereby instructed to mail notice to each registered owner of the Bonds not less than thirty days prior to the date fixed for redemption, all in accordance with the resolution authorizing the Bonds.
