

RESOLUTION 2003- 5

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 2, Section 205 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, place cross walks at appropriate locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to provide for marked cross walks protecting pedestrian rights, both north and south bound across 11th Street on the west side of Avenue G, at its intersection with 11th Street and both east and west bound across Avenue G on the north side of 11th Street at its intersection with Avenue G.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CIT OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place marked cross walks protecting pedestrian rights, both north and south bound across 11th Street on the west side of Avenue G at its intersection with 11th Street and both east and west bound across Avenue G on the north side of 11th Street at its intersection with Avenue G.

Section 2. The Street Superintendent is directed to erect such signs in accordance with the latest edition of the Manual Of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.


Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the placement of such cross walk markings and signage.
