

RESOLUTION 2004- 1

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 5, Section 205 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, designate pedestrian cross walks at appropriate locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to designate pedestrian cross walks from East to West on the South side of 13<sup>th</sup> Street where it crosses Avenue H, and from North to South on the East Side of Avenue H where it crosses 13<sup>th</sup> Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place designate pedestrian cross walks from East to West on the South side of 13<sup>th</sup> Street where it crosses Avenue H, and from North to South on the East Side of Avenue H where it crosses 13<sup>th</sup> Street; and provide markings therefore in accordance with the standards for uniform traffic control devices.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the markings and placement of appropriate signs.
