RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY BY PRIVATE SALE AND ESTABLISHING THE MANNER AND TERMS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg deem the personal property hereafter described to be excess and no longer of use or benefit to the City of Gothenburg; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg deem it appropriate to offer for sale the property hereafter described by private sale.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Personal property described as shown on attached Exhibit "A". The property shall be sold by sealed bid to be delivered to the City Clerk on or before December 18, 2009 at 2:00 P.M., at which time the bids will be taken and the personal property awarded.

The purchase price shall be paid in cash or certified funds on the date such purchaser is given possession of the personal property, which shall occur from time to time within 60 days from the date of this resolution.

- <u>Section 2</u>. The City of Gothenburg further finds that the value of the above-described truck is greater than \$5,000.00.
 - Section 3. The City of Gothenburg further sets a minimum bid of \$5,500.00.
 - Section 4. The City of Gothenburg reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
 - <u>Section 5</u>: An Ordinance confirming this sale shall not be required.
- Section 6. The personal property described above shall be sold "as is", with no warranties, whether expressed or implied.

Section 7. A copy of this resolution shall be posted and labeled as "Notice of Sale" in three prominent places within the city of Gothenburg and shall be published one time prior to the sale in the *Gothenburg Times* at least 7 days prior to the sale. Such sale of property shall not occur until 7 days after the posting of this resolution.
