

RESOLUTION 2010- 13

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Section 72.001 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code, designate the locations for restricted parking and the placement of signs for the regulation of parking, including Handicap Parking signs at appropriate locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to designate two locations on 9th Street between Lake Avenue and Avenue D for as restricted parking for vehicles bearing Handicap Parking Permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following locations are designated as restricted parking for those vehicles bearing a duly authorized Handicap Parking Permit, to wit: the 10th street side public parking space on the north side of 9th Street, and the 1st street side public parking space on the south side of 9th Street, both as measured from the east line of Avenue D, and lying between Lake Avenue and Avenue D in the City of Gothenburg.

Section 2. The Gothenburg State Bank (the "bank") owns property (the "bank property") adjacent to the 10th street side public parking space on the north side of 9th Street as measured from the east line of Avenue D, and lying between Lake Avenue and Avenue D in the City of Gothenburg. The bank has improved the bank property by designing a drive through facility that will utilize the bank property in the future as a drive through banking lane. Such future use would require a bank customer exiting the bank property to drive a vehicle through the handicapped parking space located adjacent to the bank property. Therefore, the designation of a handicapped parking space at the 10th street side public parking space on the north side of 9th Street, and the 1st

street side public parking space on the south side of 9th Street, both as measured from the east line of Avenue D, and lying between Lake Avenue and Avenue D in the City of Gothenburg shall cease on the 90th day after the bank notifies the City Clerk, in writing, of its intent to utilize the bank property as a drive through banking lane.

Section 3 Street Superintendent is hereby directed to mark the spaces designated in Section 1 hereof as restricted for vehicles bearing a duly authorized Handicap Parking Permit, in accordance with the standards for uniform traffic control devices.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon placement of the appropriate signage and marking.
