

RESOLUTION 2011- 3

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, from time to time deems it appropriate to sell and dispose of excess personal property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska deems it appropriate to sell certain property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Gothenburg hereby deems the following described personal property to be excess property not needed by the City of Gothenburg, to-wit:

ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT

Scrap Copper and Aluminum Wire

Section 2. The above described personal property shall be sold to the highest bidder, filing a written bid with the city clerk on or before the 25th day of March, 2011 at the hour of 2:00 PM.

Section 3. Following the passage of this resolution, the clerk shall post notice of the proposed sale in three prominent places within the City for a period of not less than 7 days prior to the sale of the property. The notice shall give general description of the property offered for sale and state the terms and conditions of sale.

Section 4. The property shall be sold "as is" without warranties of any kind expressed or implied.


Section 5. Payment in full shall be required by good funds at the completion of the auction.

Section 7. The Mayor is directed to execute the bill of sale, if requested, to the property upon receipt of funds for such property.


