

RESOLUTION 2016- 9

WHEREAS, The City of Gothenburg (the, "City") is currently proposing Improvement Districts for paving for which assessments against property owners may be made; and

WHEREAS, The City has historically assessed property owners 100% of the cost of front footage (as the block is laid out) for the paving improvements; and

WHEREAS, The City has historically assessed the cost of side yard improvements to property owners as follows: 50% to properties within the first 50 feet from the street, 30% to properties between 50 and 100 feet from the street, and 20% to properties between 100 and 150 feet from the street; and


WHEREAS, It is the opinion of this City that the cost of improvements has reached a point at which the sharing of costs has become necessary to assist property owners in paving districts; and that such assistance may be different for each project due to cost; and

WHEREAS, The City desires that any formula for assistance should honor those property owners who have fully paid assessments in the past by setting a minimum assessment level to a level that is at least equal to historical assessments, with the potential for sharing the responsibility of exceedingly higher assessments, if necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the City hereby states a Resolution of Intent of the following for the 2016-2017 paving projects:


For assessments of \$105 per lineal foot or greater, the City will share up to 1/3 of the costs; except that the City's share shall be limited to reducing the property owner's cost to a minimum of \$105. In addition, for assessments greater than \$125 per lineal foot, the City will share costs to the extent necessary to limit the property owner's cost to no more than \$125 per lineal foot.
