

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-1

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA ACCEPTING IMPROVEMENTS IN PAVING DISTRICT NOS. 2016-1 AND 2016-2; FINDING THE COSTS OF IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN AND ESTABLISHING THE TIME AND PLACE TO SIT AS A BOARD OF EQUALIZATION AND ASSESSMENT TO EQUALIZE AND LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS IN PAVING DISTRICT NOS. 2016-1 AND 2016-2; AND RELATED MATTERS**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska (the “City”) hereby find and determines as follows:

(a) Pursuant to Ordinance No. 939, the City has duly created Paving District Nos. 2016-1 and 2016-2, of the City (collectively referred to herein as the “Districts”) and the City has contracted for the construction of certain improvements in each of the Districts (collectively, the “Improvements”).

(b) Miller & Associates Consulting Engineers, P.C., in Kearney, Nebraska, special engineers (the “Engineers”), has filed with the Clerk its Certificate stating that (1) the construction of the Improvements in each of the Districts has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications for such work, and (2) recommending that the Improvements be accepted and approved by the Mayor and Council.

(c) The Engineers have prepared and filed with the Clerk on or before the date of this resolution a map of the property in each of the Districts and a tentative schedule of assessments in each of the Districts which shall be open for public inspection, upon request, at the office of the City.

**Section 2.** The Improvements have been completed and are hereby accepted and approved by the Mayor and Council. All actions taken by the City’s officers, employees and agents in obtaining and completing the Improvements are hereby adopted, ratified and approved.

**Section 3.** The Council finds and determines that the cost of constructing the Improvements in each of the Districts, including (a) the cost of improvements of intersections and areas formed by the crossing of streets, avenues and alleys, and (b) the cost of the improvements opposite abutting property (being all said improvements exclusive of intersections and areas formed by the crossing of streets, avenues and alleys), is as follows:

**Section 4.** The Council shall hold a meeting on Tuesday, February 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 409 Ninth Street in the City for the purpose of sitting as a Board of Equalization and Assessment to equalize and levy special assessments on the lots and parcels of land abutting on or adjacent to the Improvements constructed in each of the Districts. The Clerk's submission for and publication of notice of the time of holding such meeting and the purpose for which it is held in the *Gothenburg Times*, a legal newspaper of general circulation in the City, on January 17, 2018, January 24, 2018, January 31, 2018, February 7, 2018 and February 14, 2018, which publications run for at least four (4) weeks before the date of such meeting, is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed. The Clerk is directed to mail a copy of such notice to all interested parties as required by law. All actions taken by the Clerk, City Administrator or other City officials in connection with the publication and mailing of such notice are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed in all respects.

**Section 5.** If any section or other part of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its due passage and approval as provided by law.
