

ORDINANCE 2012-874

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 94, SECTION 94.03;
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A copy of Title IX, Chapter 94, Section 94.03 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is attached hereto as Exhibit #1.

Section 2. Title IX, Chapter 94, Section 94.03 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 94.03 LAKE HELEN RECREATION AREA VESSELS.

§ 94.03 LAKE HELEN RECREATION AREA VESSELS.

(A) All vessels used on either lake of the Lake Helen recreation area shall at all times comply with the rules and regulations for vessels set forth in the Nebraska Administrative Code, Title 163, Chapter 3.


(B) All vessels used on either lake of the Lake Helen recreation area shall be operated in such a manner as to not produce a wake, as defined in the Nebraska Administrative Code, Title 163, Chapter 3.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be published and shall be effective after such publication, according to law.

Exhibit A

§ 94.03 LAKE HELEN RECREATION AREA VESSELS.

(A) All vessels used on either lake of the Lake Helen recreation area shall be either non-powered or electrically powered. No vessels powered by internal combustion engines shall be allowed. Electrically powered vessels shall be allowed on the larger lake, only. No electrically powered vessels shall be operated under the walking bridge between the two lakes.

(B) All vessels shall be hand carried from designated parking areas to the water edge. No parking or driving on the grass shall be allowed. No ramps to unload vessels into the water shall be provided or allowed.

(C) No vessels shall be operated in excess of five mph. All vessels shall be operated at speeds which shall avoid wash and wake which may cause discomfort, hazard, injury or damage to other persons, vessels or property.

(D) No littering from vessels on the water shall be allowed.
